
WHO • EATS WHO?



The Food Web

In the ocean, animals have to hunt for food to survive, while being hunted by other **predators**.

The complicated business of 'who eats who' is known as a **food web**.

Primary producers make their own food, usually by photosynthesis.

Primary consumers

eat the primary producers.


Secondary consumers

eat the primary consumers.

Each producer or consumer has a different **trophic level.**This is chosen by the position the organism occupies in the food web.

In one food web there can be many **food chains**.

Can you make up three different chains from this food web?




Did you know?
